BRIEF COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS:

Book Fair - An annual Fall and Spring School Book Fair is held in conjunction with the School Librarian. Volunteers help to set up and check out merchandise. This is an all day event held in the Atrium.

Round Table (School Store) - This Committee would organize responsibilities of the School Stores near the Atrium and the football field (during games). The Committee will oversee (for both locations) the work schedule, product selection, and any signage at school, including electronic birthday sign during the academic year.

Teacher Appreciation - Lunches and any other type of Teacher Appreciation work in the Fall and Spring are coordinated by this Committee.

Student Appreciation - The Committee will work with the Administration to develop incentives and recognition for inspiring work by students.

Parent Class Representatives - The Committee would seek parents in each grade to serve as class parents and liaisons between the teachers, parents, administration and the Parents' Association.

Punkin' Night – This TA's biggest annual Fall parent fundraising event and is scheduled in coordination with the school to provide an evening of carnival-type games, music, and refreshments. This event is held at the school. (Date TBA, Monday in October)

Bake Sale -- This annual Spring fundraising event will be planned, organized and executed under the direction of this Committee. Baked goods, casseroles, and other delicious treats are sold at this all day event in the Atrium. (Date TBA, usually March)

Blue and Gold Day (aka Field Day) – Parent coordinators organize refreshment/lunch areas and lend support for the annual field day events taking place, as requested by the faculty organizers. (Date TBA, usually early May)

Parent Education - The Parent Education Committee plans, promotes and sponsors programs to educate and support parents concerning academic trends, new initiatives at TA, alcohol, drug use and abuse, and other issues that relate to the promotion of safe choices by their children. Volunteers are welcome to provide logistical support for this committee.

Volunteer/Welcome Committee - This Committee, Chaired by the VP, works with the Office of Admission, ILTC and the Parents's Association President to create Welcome Packs for new families and other welcoming/introduction material for the beginning of the year. This Committee can also assist in the gathering of volunteers and identification of potential volunteers through the Admissions Office.
